VIS S.A., responding to every single need of its customers, understands the significance of the basic demands, which should accompany the packaging material and these are the safe, hygienic transportation of the goods, so that they can be fully accepted by the consumers.

VIS S.A., has already been adjusted with the Greek as well as the European legislation, as far as the suitability of the carton boxes been produced, for the food industry. Specifically, VIS S.A., is able to offer packaging materials for:

- Direct contact with moist & fatty foodstuffs, since they fully comply with the specifications specified by:
 - European regulation 2004/1935/EC, which has replaced the 89/109/EC as well as the 89/509/EC.
 - All the complementary Greek legislation for the suitability of the packaging materials for the food industry, including the article 24 amendment, of the Greek Food & Beverage Code (1868/16-12-2004).
 - The European regulation 2023/2006/EC about the Good Manufacturing Practice of all materials for food packaging.
 - European regulation 10/2011 concerning the plastic packaging materials which come into contact with foodstuffs (after special request from customers).
- Direct contact with dry and non-fatty foodstuffs, or with foodstuffs, which are to be washed or peeled, prior to their consumption like oranges, water melons, tomatoes etc.
- Indirect contact with foodstuffs (secondary or tertiary packaging). In this case and according to the type of the primary or secondary packaging as well as the product itself, customer is strongly advised to conduct a hazard analysis, in order to trace the emigration probability of the pollutant towards the foodstuffs.
- Neither fluid dyes nor converters, used in our production process, include the substance 4methylbenzophenone. All raw and auxiliary materials comply with the specifications of REACH Regulation and ECHA list of all Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC).

At this point we must take into consideration the continuous effort of VIS S.A. not only for the preservation but the improvement of the existing production conditions, so that the hygienic packaging of foodstuffs is secured.
